

## 2006 Eden Valley Riesling

Langmeil's Riesling is hand picked from very old, tangled, dry farmed Riesling vines grown on ancient soil in the cooler Eden Valley, high above the Barossa Valley Floor.

After harvest the pristine fruit is gently pressed and fermented at cool temperatures to produce this delicate, yet intense wine, balanced with crisp natural acidity, typical of the renowned Eden Valley region of the Barossa.

In its youth this wine extols the affinity between Riesling and the Eden Valley and will continue to do so after bottle aging.

**Colour:** Very pale straw with brilliant white gold hues

**Aroma:** A lovely citrus blossom floral bouquet with hints of fresh lime, talc and minerality

**Palate:** The zesty lime fruits dominate the palate with a long balanced acid and mineral finish
