

2005 Jackaman's Cabernet Sauvignon

Colour: Deep crimson red

Nose: Black currant and mulberry jump out of the glass, complimented with lovely biscuity French oak characters and a hint of mint

Palate: Rich black currant fruit characters combine with cassis to create mouth filling palate weight with the sweetness of French oak to build complexity. The finish is long with herbaceous, briary notes and firm but fine tannins to complete the picture
