### [ WINEMAKING NOTES ]

This special wine is made from premium Cabernet Sauvignon grapes from the Barossa Valley. The skin contact was only 24 hours, capturing the essence of the fruit but with fine tannins. The result is a light, crisp, beautifully coloured wine with the unmistakable taste of summer berries. A wine produced by our climate for our climate, the ideal drink for a summer's day - serve chilled.

**COLOUR** • Light red with pink and purple hues.

**NOSE** • Fresh strawberries and rose blossom mingle deliciously with hints of toffee apple.

**PALATE** • Juicy summer berries tantalise the taste buds with the raspberry lolly sweetness balanced nicely with zingy and zesty acidity which transforms into a crisp Granny Smith apple finish.
