



2000 Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon

Colour: Very deep red.

Aroma: Strong varietal characters of briary blackcurrants, cassis and menthol with lovely biscuity cedary French oak.

Palate: Intense sweet fruit flows from the aromas with a full mouth feel and fine French oak tannin.

The vineyards are in three prominent sub-regions of the Barossa Valley renowned for their quality - Dorrien, Stonewell and Rowland Flat.

Limited production to maintain the standard of previous vintages.

From a select parcel of Cabernet Sauvignon, we drain the free run to make the Bella Rouge. The balance becomes a more concentrated component in the final blend, offering intense flavour and colour.
