



2001 Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon

Colour: Deep crimson.

Aroma: Typical Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon on the nose with black currents, mulberry and hints of menthol liquorice and cassis melds with the cedar and biscuit characters from the new French oak barrel ferments.

Palate: Juicy berries and oak character meld into a full palate with a firm tannin structure and lovely hints of liquorice and blueberries on the finish.

The vineyards from which we source our premium Cabernet fruit are in three prominent sub-regions of the Barossa Valley renowned for their quality, Dorrien, Stonewell and Rowland Flat. There is limited production to maintain the standard of previous vintages. From a select parcel of Cabernet Sauvignon, we drain the free run to make the Bella Rouge and therefore the balance becomes a more concentrated component in the final blend, offering intense flavour and colour.
