

2002 Eden Valley Riesling

Colour: Pale Straw

Aroma: Lime, Citrus Blossom with hints of Bready Yeast Characters

Palate: Brown lime fills the mouth with a long dry crisp finish.

Description: Hand-picked from the tangled Riesling vine, then gently whole bunch pressed to produce this delicate yet intense wine, typical of the famous Eden Valley region of the Barossa. Sweet lime pineapple with a hint of citrus blossom is balanced perfectly with the natural acidity of an exceptional vintage. Ideally can be drunk now but will reward time in the bottle over the next five years or so.

Riesling is the ideal wine as an aperitif and can be matched well with seafood and light bodied summer meals.
