

2002 Barossa Shiraz 'Valley Floor'

Colour: Deep crimson with purple hue.

Aroma: Rich raspberry, mulberry and blood plum fruits marry

with chocolate and violet hints and a touch of liquorice.

Palate: The fruits flow onto the palate, which is rich, full, and lingering with briary notes, spice and fine oak tannin. This wine

is very much a youngster.

Blend of old and new Shiraz vines sourced from the Valley Floor, complementing the different flavours which come from each individual vineyard. The vines range from 120, 70 to 50 years old from selected low yielding, minimally irrigated vineyards with exceptional soils and characteristics.

We obtain more Shiraz than we require for the bottle, enabling us to pick and choose, selecting the best fruit from each vineyard. Minimal handling, fining and filtration maximise the quality of the fruit.
