2003 'The Freedom' Shiraz

The Auricht family planted the first Shiraz vineyard at Langmeil in the mid 1840s of which a few acres still remain.

When Langmeil Winery purchased the property, this vineyard had lain untended for almost a decade. It has taken four years to prune it back to a manageable condition.

These very old dry grown Shiraz vines are hand pruned, hand picked; and yield less than two tonnes of grapes per acre, thereby producing fruit with extreme intensity of colour and flavour. Made as a single vineyard wine since 1997, *The Freedom* Shiraz will continue to showcase this vineyard and the unique and rare quality of its wine for many years to come.

Colour: Intense crimson with purple hues.

Aroma: A very rich nose of blueberry, mulberry and blood plum with hints of violets and subtle biscuit, vanilla and cedary French oak characters.

Palate: The fruitfulness flows onto the palate which is extremely rich and full, balanced with lashings of fine but firm grape and oak tannins. A wine with youthful austerity and an incredibly long and fruitful finish.
