Palate:

2003 Langmeil 'Three Gardens' Shiraz/Grenache/Mourvedre

Colour: Medium depth of lovely red crimson hues.

Nose: Cherries, raspberries, sweet spice and Christmas pudding dominate the aroma with hints of liquorice and violets adding to the complexity.

Aroma flows onto the palate with dominate characters of cherries and raspberries. Medium bodied but generous in flavour with fine, slightly chalky tannins and a long yet youthfully austere finish.
