

Eden Valley Riesling

Langmeil's Riesling is hand picked from very old, tangled, dry farmed Riesling vines grown on ancient soils in the cooler Eden Valley, high above the Barossa Valley floor.

After harvest the pristine fruit is gently pressed and fermented at cool temperatures to produce this delicate, yet intense wine, balanced with crisp natural acidity, typical of the renowned Eden Valley region of the Barossa.

In its youth this wine extols the affinity between Riesling and the Eden Valley and will continue to do so after bottle aging

Colour: Brilliant Pale Straw with Tones of Green.

Aroma: A Tropical Bouquet of Limes and Pineapple with hints of Citrus Blossom and Minerality.

Palate: Lovely Tropical Fruits flow onto the palate with the Sweet Limey Citrus is balanced right through to the Zingy and Zesty finish.
